General Points – There is no need for a ticket

The buses will stop at other bus stops on the route, should you require, please contact the Music Centre in advance to arrange in the first instance however please be punctual; they cannot wait for you.

- Please ensure that your instrument is safely stowed before the bus drives off. If you have larger or multiple instruments, the driver will help you on board and to secure them in designated parts of the bus.
- Passengers must remain in their seats when the bus is in motion.

Cost – Please let us know if your child gets the bus so that we can update the fee

The transport expenses are subsidised, however, it is still necessary for every pupil using the buses to pay a standard flat rate of £21.00 per term. This charge should also be paid, in advance, each term. It is a standard rate irrespective of where you live on the routes mentioned above, and of age. This is in addition to the termly membership fees paid by all members of the Manx Youth Orchestras and Guitar Ensemble.
